




Year Two (2023-2024): Year of Parish Revival Mission

Have you ever known anyone who just seems to ooze hospitality? This person just happens to have a charger if you need one, or an extra sweatshirt or jacket when you are chilled. Maybe \$20 for gas or food gets slipped in your pocket or added to your Venmo. A smile might greet you on an especially bad day or an offer to lend a hand when you are just about to drop the immense load you've managed to carry for much too long.

These are the things that come to mind while reading from the book of Wisdom this morning. A person who is able to reach out to another person on the day's journey no matter the situation. A graceful peace often accompanies this individual even when their own life is busy, and yet there is an intentional welcoming and shared response to those they encounter.

The Psalm, "My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord" continues this theme of reaching out. It is a prayer to see God in daily life as well as in eternal life. Being able to see the Lord in the everyday situations of my life is the building block of my faith in Him. As a child I wasn't able to verbalize that it was God's breath or touch I was seeing in a meal on the table or my Mom or Dad's smile. I could recognize when these things were missing and sometimes made it really hard to stay focused or believe that things would be resolved. I wasn't aware that I needed to thank the Lord for providing for me as my parents took care of my needs. I wasn't really aware that having loving and caring parents was itself a tremendous blessing and witness of love and faithfulness.

Today's parable of ten virgins waiting for the bridegroom can seem harsh. Five women turn up their lamps to light the way and accompany the bridegroom into the wedding celebration. The five who were not prepared came back with oil to find the door to the festivities locked. The awareness of what is needed in the moment comes through the faithful practice of God's way of life and is developed by wisdom and grace.

Lord, thank you ahead of time for the grace to ask about and know your Way. Help me to recognize and acknowledge the wisdom shared by those who are an example to me. Allow me to be a witness and light for others. Amen.



To Get or Not to Get Vaccines . . .

Soon, the highways will get crowded with our northern friends escaping their frigid climates and joining us for the holidays and beyond. Unfortunately, some of them will be bringing flu, RSV and COVID germs with them to spread amongst our population.

The CDC has posted in their vaccine schedule for 2023-24 that routine annual influenza vaccination is recommended for all persons aged 6 months or older who do not have contraindications. Emphasis is placed on all persons over 60 and those with compromised immune systems and respiratory conditions such as asthma and COPD.

For most persons who need only 1 dose of influenza vaccine for the season, vaccination should ideally be offered during September or October. However, vaccination should continue after October and throughout the season as long as influenza viruses are circulating and unexpired vaccine is available.

The CDC has stated that Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) causes substantial morbidity and mortality in older adults. In May 2023, the Food and Drug Administration approved the first two vaccines for prevention of RSV lower respiratory tract disease (LRTD) for use in adults aged 60 and older.

Both vaccine products demonstrated that with a single RSV vaccine dose there was a moderate to high efficacy in preventing symptomatic RSV associated LRTD among adults aged 60 and older. This past June, the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices recommended that persons aged 60 years and older receive a single dose of RSV vaccine. After speaking with a pharmacist and my PCP, it is understood that this recommendation will be recommended annually.

There is controversary with the new COVID 19 mRNA vaccine by Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna. Also, Novavax has developed a non-mRNA protein vaccine to give patients and doctors a choice. Each company has a vaccination schedule depending on previous vaccines received or no previous vaccines received.

Recently, the Florida Surgeon General issued this warning: Tallahassee, Fla.— On September 13, 2023, the State Surgeon General issued guidance on the recently approved mRNA COVID-19 boosters. Health care providers are expected to include information found in this guidance in discussions with their patients regarding the mRNA COVID-19 vaccines. Based on the high rate of global immunity and currently available data, the State Surgeon General recommends against the COVID-19 booster for individuals under 65. Individuals 65 and older should discuss this information with their health care provider, including potential concerns.

Saint of the Week

Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini (1850-1917) November 13

Burly longshoremen glared at the woman in widow's dress who interrupted their drinking to beg money, in broken English, for her orphanage. The bar exploded in laughter as one man responded by spitting in her face. "That was for me," the woman smiled. "Do you have anything for the children?" Given today's national debate, could it be as much God's sense of humor as God's will for our sanctification that our first "American" saint should be an immigrant and naturalized citizen? Frances Cabrini, adopting the name "Xavier," confided to Pope Leo XIII her longing to follow her Jesuit patron to Asia. But the Pope replied, "Not East—West!" So she and her Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart exchanged exotic dreams of China for the impoverished reality of Italian ghettos across the United States and Central and South America. Before her death, Frances had founded seventy educational, health care, child, and family service institutions. Today, from Siberia to Ethiopia, in sixteen countries, Mother Cabrini's sisters and lay associates embody her practical spirituality: "Let's get to work! We'll have eternity to rest!" -Peter Scagnelli




