





The Long Goodbye. . . . (Part 1)

Today, having a loved one live with a terminal illness for an extended period of time is replacing sudden and unexpected death as our new normal. Family and close friends, along with the person with the terminal illness, now have much longer time to face the prospect of death and to say their goodbyes. This has changed the grieving process to one with several stages that is shared by families, not just the patient.

Two thirds of those who are diagnosed with cancer currently have a five-year survival rate. The result is that death has become less and less sudden and unexpected. We now experience a process that begins with a life-threatening diagnosis, that continues with a period of treatments, and ends eventually in death. This means that the individual and the family now have to come to terms with the idea of "living with death" for a prolonged period of time.

The nature of death and dying has changed dramatically; therefore, the way we grieve has also changed. The mourning begins while the patient is still living and breathing and includes the dying person as well. This process has the potential to alter lifestyles and forces the family to confront issues that once were dealt with only after the death of the loved one. It can also evoke issues from the past that were never fully addressed or resolved.

Grief is a family matter as much as it is an individual one. When we use the word family, we include not only blood relations, but all those who have a significant connection to the person who carries the diagnosis.

Over the next few weeks, we will explore how these changes and stages impact the family as well as the terminally ill patient. Keep in mind that the content of this message is not a replacement for professional advice, diagnosis or treatment, but is intended to provide information and to open up dialogue among family members.


