



Praise be to Jesus Christ Our Saviour!



#### The Long Goodbye....(Part 3)

We will begin to explore a five-stage model for family grief as outlined by the Harvard Help Guide when a family member has been given a diagnosis of a terminal illness or a potentially terminal illness. There are no hard-and-fast boundaries separating these stages. Every family will experience each stage, but may experience issues associated with more than one stage at any given time. The stages vary in length and intensity, depending on the length of the terminal illness and whether there are any significant periods of remission.

**Stage 1:** Crisis – The diagnosis of a terminal illness disrupts the family's equilibrium. How each member reacts at this stage depends upon the history and current status of the relationship with the ill family member. Whether the loved one is a spouse, a parent, or a child, and what the patient's past and current roles in the family, dictate the impact of the diagnosis on each family member.

Anxiety is the most common initial reaction to the news, but if the relationship with the ill family member has been strained or alienated, the feelings of guilt, resentment and anger may surface. If the terminally ill family member is a child or young adult, anger at the possibility of an early death may become the dominant emotion shared by family members at this first stage.

Knowing what to expect in terms of emotional reactions, where to seek help, and how to support the dying loved one are all issues that surface during this first stage.

**Stage 2:** Unity – The reality of impending death pushes family members to put longstanding complaints or grudges on hold as they pull together in this second stage of grieving. The needs of the dying family member become paramount. This may cause some internal conflict for family members with unresolved issues with the patient.

A major issue for all family members is how they define their roles with respect to one another and the terminally ill member. If not prepared, family members may find themselves regressing into roles as children or adolescents, but not a role they would consciously choose now as adults.

The family has much work to do at this second stage: choosing and working with a medical team; navigating the social services maze; pursuing and qualifying for entitlements for the patient; and ensuring that critical legal work (wills, living wills, power of attorney documents, etc.) is completed. How the family organizes itself so that these tasks can be completed has a powerful psychological effect on each member.

Next week, we will continue with stages 3 & 4, (Upheaval and Resolution).
