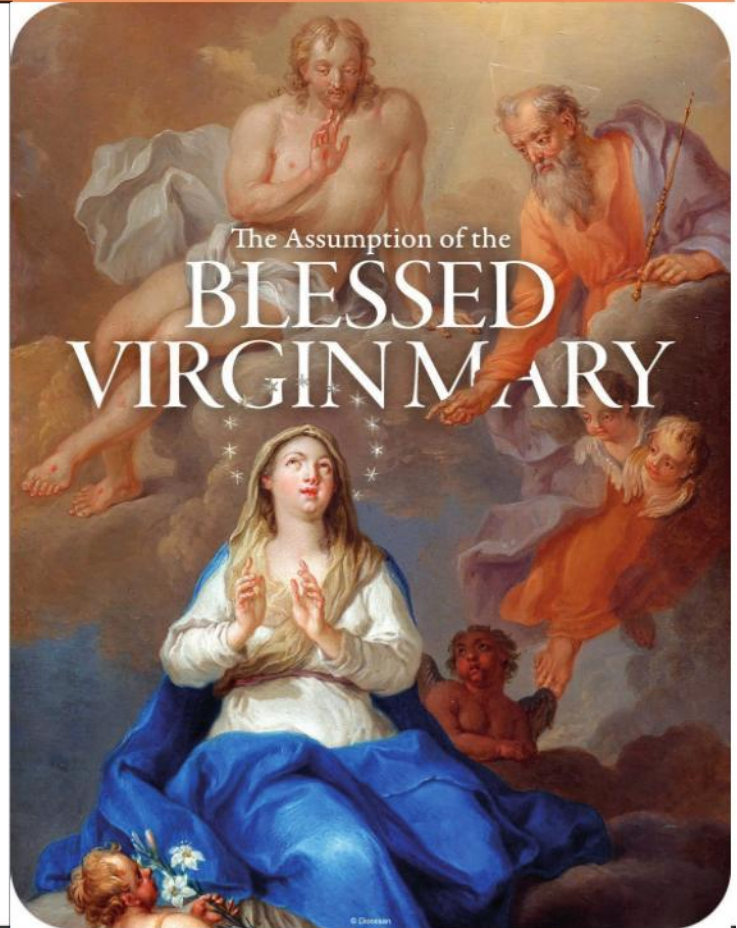

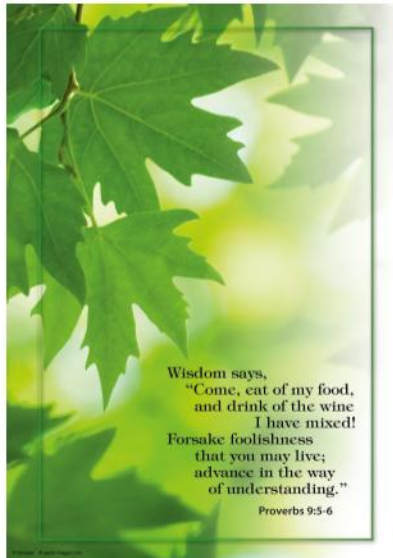

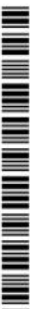

The Long Goodbye. . .(Part 4)

Last week, we began a five-stage model for family grief as outlined by the Harvard Help Guide when a family member has been given a diagnosis of a terminal illness or a potentially terminal illness. We covered Stage 1: Crisis, and Stage 2: Unity. We will continue with our third stage.

Stage 3: Upheaval – The family of the terminally ill member will enter into this third stage of grieving if the process of dying continues for a long time. Due to the treatments given today that can extend life, this has become more typical than not.

At some point the characteristics of the **Unity** stage undergo significant changes and family members become stressed with emotions on edge. The suppressed feelings of complaints or grudges begin to surface. Many family members begin to experience mixed feelings of ambivalence, guilt, anger and resentment. As they witness the process of dying and their loved one’s overall quality of life slowly deteriorating, these emotions can no longer be suppressed.

Unfortunately, or fortunately, this is when a family’s faith is put to the test. During Stage 3, the most important issue becomes being able to communicate honestly with other family members and with trusted loved ones. Suppressing thoughts and feelings about such upheavals can lead to strained relationships and eventually can cause the entire family to fall apart. This is a time for family prayer, Bible readings and attending church as a family. Keeping Christ in the midst and turning to him for strength, can provide comfort and minimize the significance of this third stage.

Stage 4: Resolution – At this stage, the terminally ill loved one’s health is typically deteriorating with periods of stabilization or temporary improvement. Family members find themselves having more memories – good and bad – of past experiences with the patient. Some of these memories may evoke feelings of joy, nostalgia or pride, while others may evoke anger, jealousy, envy, shame or embarrassment.

Stage 4 offers an unprecedented opportunity for family members to resolve longstanding issues, heal wounds, and redefine one’s role in the family. Any “family skeletons” in the closet (old rivalries, jealousies, and long-held resentments) can be brought out of the closet, dealt with, and cast away.

These issues prevent families from being able to bond together as strongly as they could and love one another unconditionally. While some family members may embrace this opportunity with enthusiasm; be aware, that others may try to avoid facing these issues openly. Facing up to them offers the family the best opportunity as a whole to move together to a happier future. This process of family grief brings us to the final stage of growth and renewal as we will outline next week in the final part of The Long Goodbye.
