



Your loving care and protection.


We ask that you keep us safe from all hurricanes which may threaten us in the coming seasons.








"Those who eat My flesh and drink My blood abide in Me, and I in them." (John 6:56)



### The Long Goodbye. . . . (Part 5)

We have come to the final stage of The Long Goodbye. Previously, we outlined the stages of Crisis, Unity, Upheaval and Resolution. The final stage:

Stage 5: Renewal – This final stage of grief begins with the funeral and the celebration of the life of the now-lost family member. This is a time of mixed emotions, including sadness, relief and joy. Sadness, because we will no longer have that person in our physical life, and we will grieve the loss of that relationship. Relief, because our loved one's suffering has ceased, and joy, because we spiritually believe that person to be on their way to a heavenly reward.

If the family has successfully experienced the previous four stages, then this final stage can open a door for collective, as well as, personal renewal. It can be a celebration of life as much as it is a marking of a loss. It can be a time of creativity and planning, as the family decides how to move forward with acknowledging anniversaries, birthdays and holidays. These can be sad times, or can be times to revitalize relationships within the family and to begin new family traditions.

Keep in mind that each family member may experience this final stage differently. There is no "normal" timetable for grieving the loss of a loved one. Each family member may be impacted differently with the loss based on their role in the family and their closeness with the lost family member. It is important to support one another during this time and recognize that this loss may be more difficult for some.

If you or a family member have been given a diagnosis of a terminal illness, I highly recommend that you read, Saying Goodbye: A Guide to Coping with a Loved One's Terminal Illness, by Barbara Okun, Ph.D. and Joseph Nowinski, Ph.D.

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
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
