Peripheral Artery Disease

Last week, we began our two-part series on Peripheral Artery Disease, also referred to as PAD. We described that PAD was caused by a buildup of fats, cholesterol, and other substances in or on the artery walls, a condition called atherosclerosis per the Mayo Clinic. This condition can be seen on your arms as well as your legs, making it difficult for your blood to carry the necessary oxygen and nutrients to the tissues in those areas that result in severe problems and pain to the affected areas.

If your physician suspects peripheral artery disease, he/she will run blood tests to check for high cholesterol and high blood sugar. Your physician will most likely do an Ankle-brachial index (ABI) which is a common test used to diagnose PAD. It compares the blood pressure in the ankle with the blood pressure in the arm. You may be asked to walk on a treadmill with blood pressure readings taken before and after exercising to check the arteries during walking.

Next, your doctor will do an ultrasound of the legs or feet. This will utilize sound waves to create a picture of how blood moves through the blood vessels of the legs or feet. A doppler ultrasound is a special type of ultrasound used to spot blocked or narrowed arteries. Finally, an Angiography is used along with a dye injected into the arteries to look for blockages. The dye will help the arteries show up more clearly on the test images.

The goals of treatment for peripheral artery disease (PAD) are twofold: First, to manage symptoms, such as leg pain, so exercise is more comfortable, and second, to improve artery health to reduce the risk of heart attack, stroke or other complications. Treatment for PAD may include lifestyle changes, medicine, and surgery. Lifestyle changes include losing weight, eating less fat, and giving up tobacco products.

If your doctor feels that your condition requires a surgical or interventive procedure, he/she may use Thrombolytic therapy. Medicine may be given directly into the affected artery to dissolve a clot that is blocking blood flow. Angioplasty and stent placement may be used in a narrowed artery to open blood flow and minimize leg pain. A tiny balloon on a tube, called a catheter, is placed in the artery. The balloon is inflated making the artery wider, increasing the blood flow. A small wire mesh tube, called a stent, may be placed in the artery to keep the artery open.

In Bypass surgery, a new path for blood to flow is created around a blocked or partially blocked artery. The surgeon takes a healthy blood vessel from another part of the body. The vessel is connected below the blocked artery creating a new pathway allowing blood to flow to the muscle.

As stated previously, please make an appointment with your physician if you are experiencing any leg or arm pain or any symptoms of peripheral artery disease.




