The Cathechists of the Good Sheperd

Do you have a child between the ages of three to six years old, who is not yet in first grade?

Here at Holy Spirit we have a fantastic program just for them called the Good Shepherd program.

Your child will be in a group that will be introduced to the wonders of our Catholic faith, and they learn by working in what is called an Atrium. Inside the Atrium, which is a miniature church, they will be shown many of the articles of our faith that are child sized, and they work hands on as they learn how each element relates to out faith. After the first year, they are able to identify all articles you will find on the altar and their purpose, why the priest is wearing the color robe he has on, learning their prayers through song and repetition. There are songs to sing to help memorize different parts of our faith along with arts and crafts projects to also help show them how our Catholic faith works. All children will need to be potty trained.

Teaching our class is Mrs. Carmen West, who has been with us and has been teaching the Good Shepherds program since it was started here at our church. Marie Cantone (you know, the nice lady in the gift shop) is a co-teacher in the class as well. The cost is \$30.00 for the entire year, and they are held on Sundays from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. Most families drop their young learners off and then they go to 10:30 Mass and then pick their child back up after Mass is over.

West Nile Virus

A mosquito bite can turn into something more severe if it bites a bird infected with West Nile virus and then bites you. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the key points to consider about West Nile Virus is that:

It can result in a febrile illness (having a fever) or neurologic disease, including meningitis or encephalitis.

There is no specific treatment for West Nile


Rest, fluids and pain medications may relieve symptoms. In severe cases, patients often need to be hospitalized to receive supportive care such as intravenous fluids, pain medication and nursing care.

Most people infected with West Nile virus do not develop any symptoms. About 1 in 5 people who are infected develop a fever with other symptoms such as headache, sore throat, muscle aches, joint pains, vomiting, diarrhea or rash. Most people who experience a fever due to West Nile Virus recover completely, but fatigue and weakness can last for weeks or even months.

About 1 in 150 people who are infected develop a severe illness affecting the central nervous system as encephalitis (inflammation of the brain) or meningitis (inflammation of the membranes that surround the brain and spinal cord). Severe illness can occur in people of any age, but people over 60 years of age are at greater risk for severe illness.

Severe illness may include high fever, headache, neck stiffness, stupor, disorientation, coma, tremors, convulsions, muscle weakness, vision loss, numbness and paralysis. People with certain medical conditions, such as cancer, diabetes, hypertension, kidney disease, and people who have received organ transplants, are at greater risk. Recovery from severe illness might take several weeks or months, and some effects may become permanent. About 1 out of 10 people who develop severe illness affecting the central nervous system die.

If you or a family member experience any of these symptoms, reach out to your healthcare provider as soon as possible. Your provider will question you about symptoms, possible exposure to mosquitoes that can carry West Nile virus, and do laboratory testing of blood or spinal fluid for a diagnosis. Don't risk your health; see your healthcare provider.


