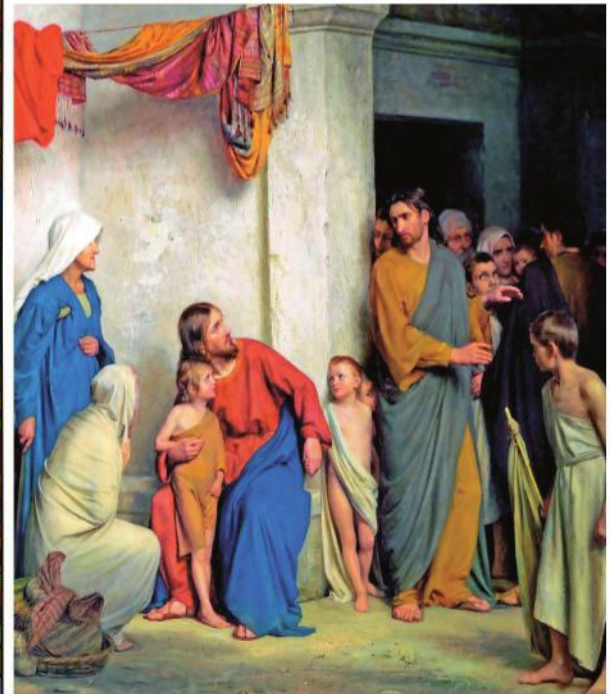

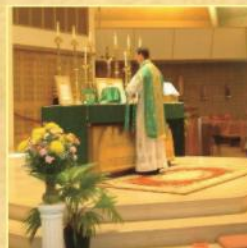

**Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
What Makes You Happy?**

St. James message of peace is as true now as it was two thousand years ago. Where else do wars and terrorism come from, than people holding on to wealth, power, or hatred? But the message James shares, and that of Jesus in the gospel, is a simple call to be different. Neither of them condemns anyone. They call us to look at what we really want and what truly brings happiness.

Jesus' disciples argued about who was greatest. Instead of slapping them down for their selfish pride, he looks at what they could be and calls them to a different attitude. To be truly happy, they must let go of pride and arrogance; they must learn that serving others is the only way to experience love and joy.

We are no different today. We have to learn that having the latest gadget, the most expensive cell-phone, or the latest-model car are at best temporary delights. And that being admired by acquaintances is never as lasting as loving someone for themselves. Jesus offers even more: the joy of being loved by God and helping others to know Him. Think about Jesus' words to the disciples: He is the Son of God, yet He wants to lead us not just to Himself, but to the Father.

Can we learn to be more excited about what God has done for us than what we did to improve our home? Can we share our faith in God's mercy instead of bragging about our golf or bowling scores? Are we more interested in impressing members of the opposite sex, or treating all people with respect?

St. James ends our second reading with a challenging statement: He says we ask but don't receive because we ask wrongly. How often do we desire things that won't really make us happy? Do we pray for things we don't really need? Would we ask God to punish those who hurt us, or to help us forgive them? Let us ask God to show us his love and to help those around us to experience it too.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Did you ever notice how often the angels are referred to during Mass? We commonly meet them in the Confiteor ("I ask blessed Mary, every virgin, all the angels and saints"), prefaces ("with angels and archangels and the whole company of heaven"), the Roman Canon ("we pray that your angel may take this sacrifice"), and Eucharistic Prayer IV ("countless hosts of angels stand before You to do Your will"). Last week and this week angels abound as we celebrated Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael yesterday and will honor the Guardian Angels on October 2.



September 29 was originally the feast day for Michael alone. Gabriel and Raphael joined him in the 1969 reform of the Church calendar. The celebration of the Guardian Angels has been observed since the sixteenth century in Spain. Pope Clement X assigned the feast to the first free day after St. Michael's in 1670, and there it has remained. Take some time this week to reflect on these, God's messengers and our protectors, and maybe even celebrate with a little angel food cake! —*Rev. James Field*

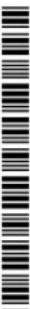

Lyme Disease, Part 2

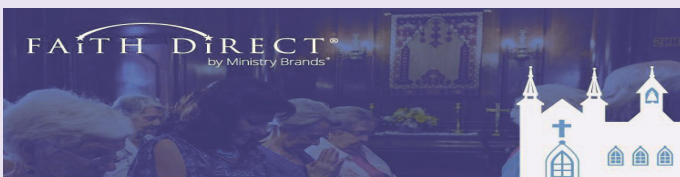
Last week, we learned that Lyme disease is an illness caused by the bite of a tick carrying the borrelia bacteria. Humans contract the disease from the bite of a tick carrying the bacteria. According to the CDC, in 2022 there were over 63,000 cases reported nationally. Additionally, there are many cases that are undiagnosed and unreported. Recent estimates using other methods suggest that approximately 476,000 people may be diagnosed and receiving treatment each year in the United States. Many of these patients who are treated based on clinical suspicion, but may not actually have Lyme disease.

The cause of the disease in North America is primarily from a bite from an infected black-legged deer tick. The tick picks up the bacteria from feeding on an infected host such as a deer or rodent. When an infected tick feeds on a person, the bacteria can move to a person’s bloodstream. The bacteria are less likely to spread Lyme disease if you can remove the tick within 24 hours.

The safest way to remove a tick is with a good eye and a pair of pointy tweezers (not typical household tweezers). 1. Clean the area around the tick bite with rubbing alcohol. 2. Get your tweezers right down on your skin so you can grab as close as possible to the tick’s head. Don’t use methods such as burning it, smothering it with petroleum jelly or painting it with nail polish.

Risk factors include where you live: mostly upper Midwest, northeastern and mid-Atlantic states, and in south central and southeastern Canada. This stated, Florida has many cases of Lyme disease especially those traveling, hiking and living in wooded, grassy or bushy (shrubby) areas.

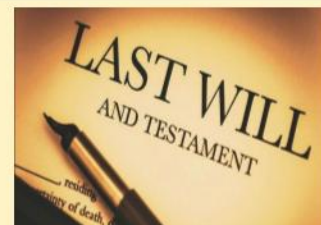
