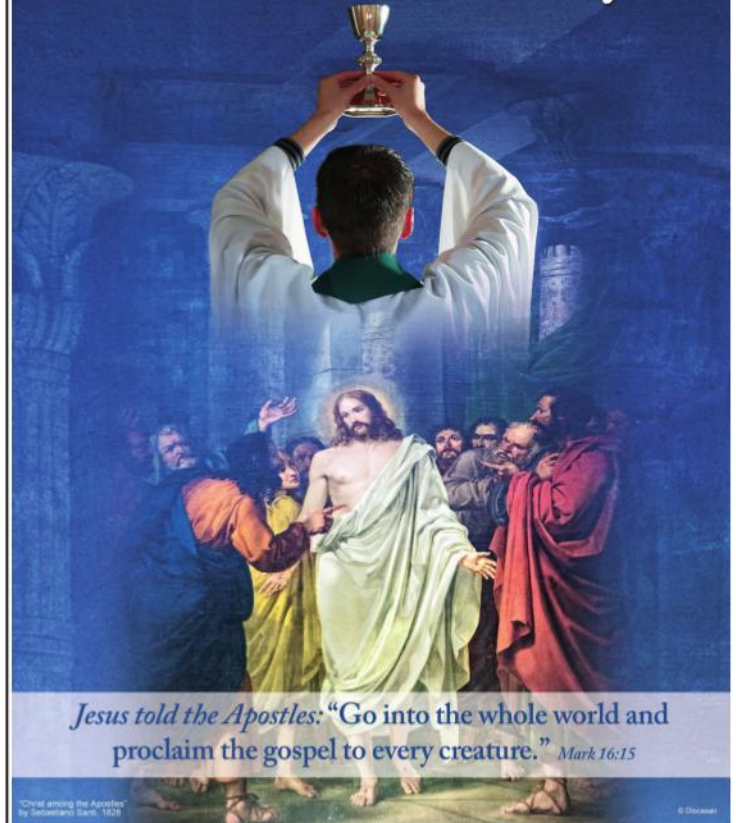

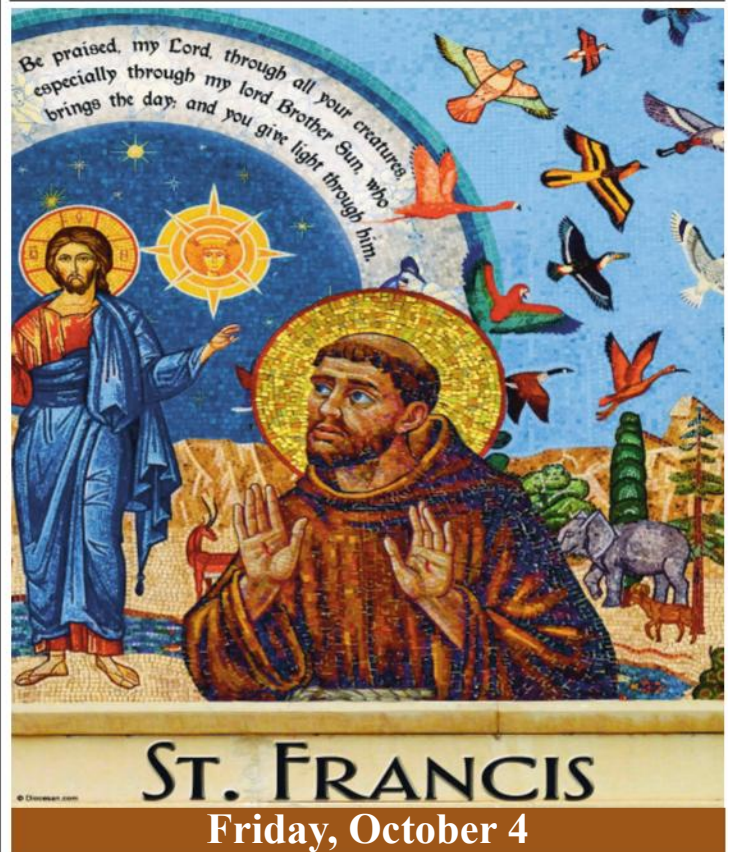

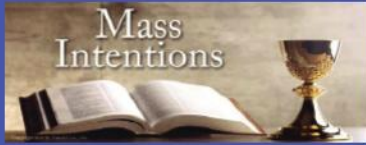

God Helps Us Cast Off Sin

In today's Gospel, we read that Christ said to His followers: "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe [in Me] to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea." He then goes on to say that if your hand, foot, or eye cause you to sin, you should cut it off or pluck it out. Now, we need not take Jesus literally and begin to chop off body parts. He certainly does not want us to harm ourselves. But He does want us to get rid of the source of sin in our lives.

What does that look like today? It could be a toxic friend who leads us away from Christ rather than to Him. It could be social media or a TV show that causes us to forgo our faith or to do something contrary to the commandments. Or it could be spending too much time on our phone and putting this "idol" before God.

Anything that leads us away from God should be cast away. But that takes a lot of moral courage. It takes us having—and sustaining—the ability to ask God for His help, to take His hand, and to allow Him to lead us. This is especially difficult when others make fun of us, when others call us names or rebuke us for our faith, or when things don't seem to go our way. During these times, we may feel abandoned by those on Earth and by God.

This loneliness can lead to despair. And that despair can pitch us into anger or even resentment, which of course can lead to sinful behavior. And you know what? That's exactly what the evil one wants. In fact, he revels in those feelings because they create distance between us and God. So as we think about driving out the things that cause us to sin, we must remember that those things include the feelings and the thoughts that pull away from our Lord.

That is why a solid prayer life is so vital. When we feel these dark thoughts creeping in on us, when we feel them about to overtake us, or when we notice things of the outside world replacing things of the spiritual world, that is when we must train ourselves to press the proverbial pause button and find a quiet place to pray, to give ourselves to God, to listen to Him, and to tell Him we trust in Him.

Better yet, go see Him in Adoration. Sit with Him. Ask for the courage and the strength to battle the evil affecting you and to cut from your life the things causing you to sin. This is what Christ asks of us. This is how we can grow closer to Him.

Lyme Disease, Final Part 3

Last week, we learned that risk factors for Lyme disease have a lot to do with where you live or frequent. Ticks that carry the borrelia bacteria are found primarily in wooded, grassy or shrubby areas. People that hunt, hike, or camp in these areas are at greatest risk.

Complications - Some people with Lyme disease report symptoms that continue after treatment. These longer-lasting symptoms may include: Arthritis that begins with Lyme disease and doesn't improve; Body aches and pains; Constant or frequent tiredness; and Memory complaints.

Some people with these symptoms may be diagnosed with post-treatment Lyme disease syndrome, or PTLDS. It is believed that these long-lasting problems may be caused by: Incomplete treatment; Reinfection with Lyme disease; Immune system response to fragments of killed bacteria; Immune system activity that harms healthy tissues, also referred to as autoimmunity; and finally conditions other than Lyme disease that have not been diagnosed.

Prevention – The best way to prevent Lyme disease is to avoid tick bites when you are outdoors. Most ticks attach themselves to your lower legs and feet as you walk or work in grassy, wooded areas or overgrown fields. After a tick attaches to your body, it often crawls upward to find a spot to burrow into your skin.

If you are in or plan to be in an area where ticks are likely to live, follow these tips to protect yourself: Use tick repellents that contain 0.5% permethrin. Spray your outdoor clothing, shoes, tent and other camping gear. Some gear and clothing may be pre-treated with permethrin. Use an insect repellent, specified for ticks, and registered with the Environmental Protection Agency on any exposed skin, except your face. Ask your pediatrician what you should use on children under age 3.

Dress for protection by wearing light-colored clothing that makes it easier for you or others to see ticks on your clothing. Avoid open-toed shoes or sandals. Wear long-sleeved shirts tucked into your pants. Wear long pants tucked into your socks.

Once home, check for any loose ticks in the shower while you wash. Check for ticks that may have burrowed. Use a mirror to check your body well. Pay attention to your underarms, hair and hairline. Also check your ears, waist, and the area between your legs, behind your knees, and inside your bellybutton. Check your gear. Before you wash your outdoor clothes, put them in the dryer on hot for at least 10 minutes to kill ticks.

It's always good to do a daily inspection for ticks on any pet that spends time outdoors.

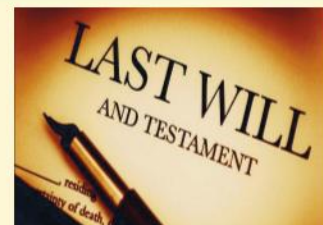
