For these great benefits it is our duty to praise the Lord in a spirit of humility and gratitude, and to offer up to Him our most earnest supplications.

That we may acknowledge our obligations as a people to Him who has so graciously granted unto us the blessings of free government and material prosperity, I, William McKinley, President of the United States, do hereby designate and set apart Thursday, the twenty-fourth day of November, for National thanksgiving and prayer, which all of the people are invited to observe with appropriate religious services in their respective places of worship. 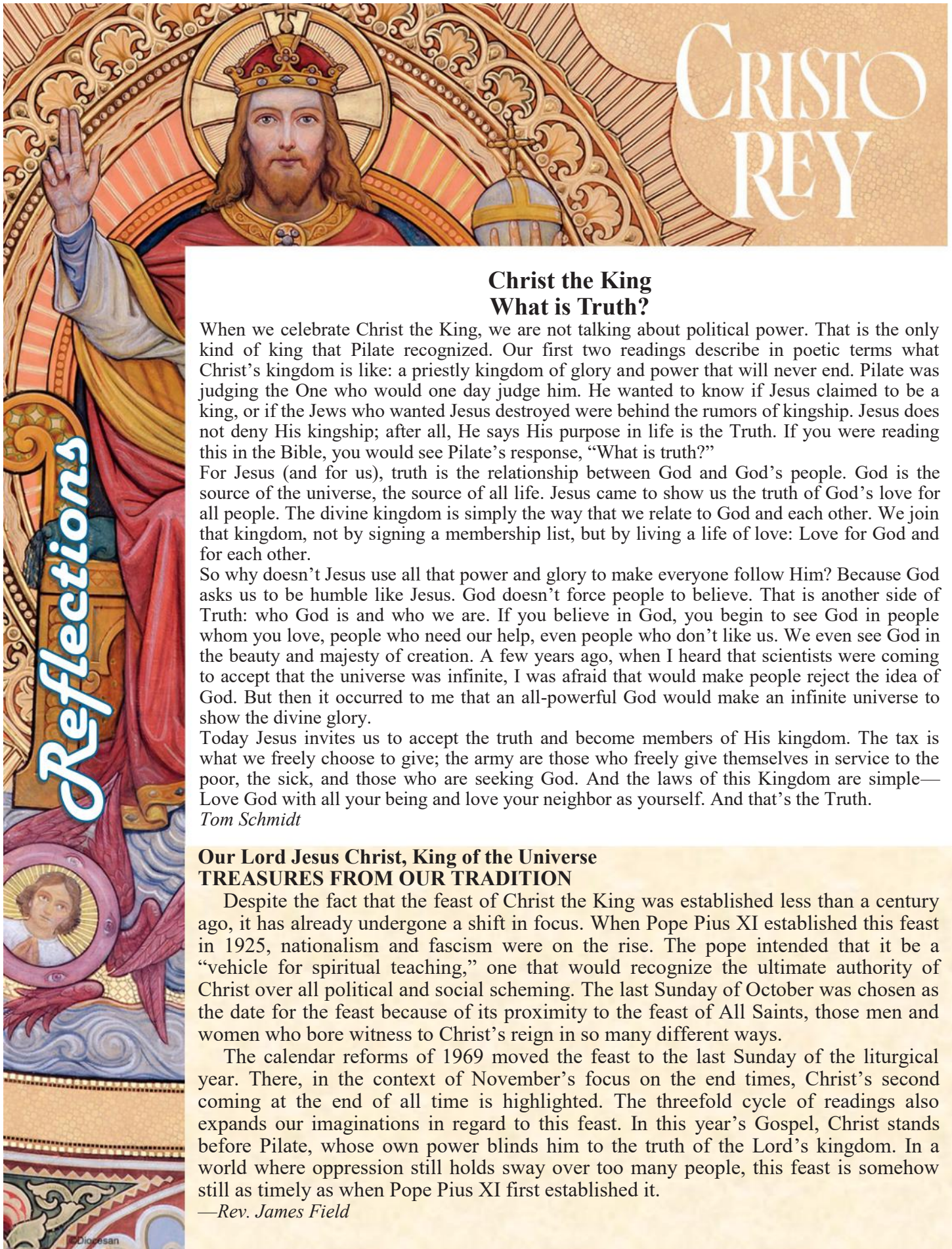

## Christ the King What is Truth?

When we celebrate Christ the King, we are not talking about political power. That is the only kind of king that Pilate recognized. Our first two readings describe in poetic terms what Christ’s kingdom is like: a priestly kingdom of glory and power that will never end. Pilate was judging the One who would one day judge him. He wanted to know if Jesus claimed to be a king, or if the Jews who wanted Jesus destroyed were behind the rumors of kingship. Jesus does not deny His kingship; after all, He says His purpose in life is the Truth. If you were reading this in the Bible, you would see Pilate’s response, “What is truth?”

For Jesus (and for us), truth is the relationship between God and God’s people. God is the source of the universe, the source of all life. Jesus came to show us the truth of God’s love for all people. The divine kingdom is simply the way that we relate to God and each other. We join that kingdom, not by signing a membership list, but by living a life of love: Love for God and for each other.

So why doesn’t Jesus use all that power and glory to make everyone follow Him? Because God asks us to be humble like Jesus. God doesn’t force people to believe. That is another side of Truth: who God is and who we are. If you believe in God, you begin to see God in people whom you love, people who need our help, even people who don’t like us. We even see God in the beauty and majesty of creation. A few years ago, when I heard that scientists were coming to accept that the universe was infinite, I was afraid that would make people reject the idea of God. But then it occurred to me that an all-powerful God would make an infinite universe to show the divine glory.

Today Jesus invites us to accept the truth and become members of His kingdom. The tax is what we freely choose to give; the army are those who freely give themselves in service to the poor, the sick, and those who are seeking God. And the laws of this Kingdom are simple—Love God with all your being and love your neighbor as yourself. And that’s the Truth.

## Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Despite the fact that the feast of Christ the King was established less than a century ago, it has already undergone a shift in focus. When Pope Pius XI established this feast in 1925, nationalism and fascism were on the rise. The pope intended that it be a “vehicle for spiritual teaching,” one that would recognize the ultimate authority of Christ over all political and social scheming. The last Sunday of October was chosen as the date for the feast because of its proximity to the feast of All Saints, those men and women who bore witness to Christ’s reign in so many different ways.

The calendar reforms of 1969 moved the feast to the last Sunday of the liturgical year. There, in the context of November’s focus on the end times, Christ’s second coming at the end of all time is highlighted. The threefold cycle of readings also expands our imaginations in regard to this feast. In this year’s Gospel, Christ stands before Pilate, whose own power blinds him to the truth of the Lord’s kingdom. In a world where oppression still holds sway over too many people, this feast is somehow still as timely as when Pope Pius XI first established it.

## GERD aka Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease

GERD happens when stomach acid frequently flows back into the muscular tube (esophagus) connecting your mouth to your stomach. Minor symptoms are referred to as heartburn or indigestion, and we can take a couple of over-the-counter Tums or Rolaids and relieve the discomfort. However, after time, the lining of the esophagus is impacted to the extent we develop acid damage.

Acid damage is a broad range of conditions that contribute to inflammation and disease. For the purpose of this article, we are focusing on the esophagus. Heartburn occurs when gastric acid from the stomach, due to a weak lower esophageal sphincter muscle or a hiatal hernia, goes the wrong way, or refluxes, up into the delicate tissues of the esophagus. This causes a burning sensation through the middle of the chest and toward the throat. Regurgitation is the sensation of food coming back up into your chest and throat after you've already swallowed it.

The following symptoms of acid damage include: hoarseness; a chronic, nagging cough; a sore throat that appears out of nowhere; a feeling of a lump being stuck in your throat; postnasal drip; allergies, shortness of breath; regurgitation; chest pain, difficulty swallowing and abdominal bloating. These symptoms may be present *with* or *without* heartburn or indigestion. For this reason, millions of people with Gerd or acid reflux\*are going undiagnosed and putting themselves at risk of long-term side effects and potentially deadly diseases, including cancer.

Risk factors that can bring on GERD are: a loss of tension in the upper (UES) and lower (LES) esophageal sphincter muscles; hiatal hernia; tobacco use of all kinds including vaping; obesity; pregnancy; caffeine, chocolate; carbonated sugary drinks; and alcohol. The biggest culprit is a diet high in acid producing foods or drinks. The UES is susceptible to damage from tobacco and alcohol. Once weakened, the UES will allow acid into the upper respiratory organs such as the mouth, larynx (voice box) and trachea (windpipe). Acid in these regions can lead to symptoms that are usually associated with acid reflux, such as: hoarseness; phlegm; postnasal drip; asthma; and shortness of breath.

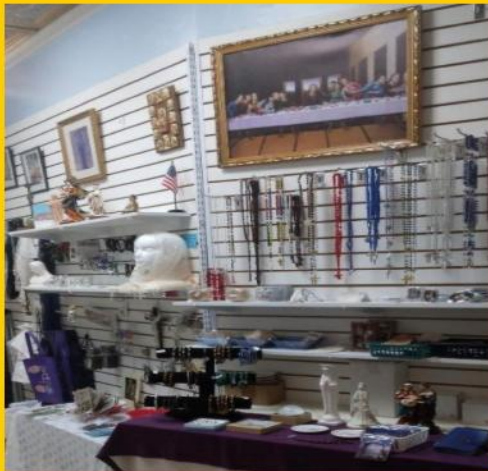
