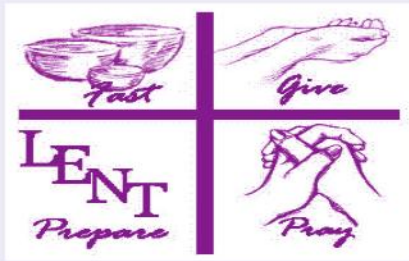

Our observance of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, a day of fast and abstinence for Catholics. At Mass on Ash Wednesday (March 5, 2025), the imposition of ashes replicates an ancient penitential practice and symbolizes our dependence upon God's mercy and forgiveness.

During Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics.

The three traditional pillars of Lenten observance are **Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving**. The Church asks us to surrender ourselves to prayer and to the reading of Scripture, to fasting and to giving alms. The fasting that all do together on Fridays is but a sign of the daily Lenten discipline of individuals and households; fasting for certain period of time, fasting from certain food, but also fasting from other things and activities. Likewise, the giving of alms is some effort to share this world equally - not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents.

The key to fruitful observance of these practices is to recognize their link to baptismal renewal. We are called not just to abstain from sin during Lent, but to true conversion of our hearts and minds as followers of Christ. We recall those water in which we are baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and-evil, and began new life in Christ.

## What is the Church's official position concerning penance and abstinence from meat during Lent?



In 1966 Pope Paul VI reorganized the Church's practice of public penance in his "Apostolic Constitution on Penance" (*Poenitemini*). The 1983 revision of the Code of Canon Law incorporated the changes made by Pope Paul. Not long after that, the U.S. bishops applied the canonical requirements to the practice of public penance in our country.

**To sum up those requirements, Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.**

Fasting as explained by the U.S. bishops means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

Abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat.

## Exemptions from the Lenten Fast

Besides those outside the age limits, those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, pregnant or nursing women according to need for meat or nourishment, manual laborers according to need, guests at a meal who cannot excuse themselves without giving great offense of causing enmity and other situations of moral or physical impossibility to observe the penitential discipline.

## Broken Heart Syndrome

Broken heart syndrome, clinically known as stress cardiomyopathy, is a temporary heart condition that can mimic a heart attack. It is typically triggered by sudden emotional or physical stress, leading to a surge in stress hormones that temporarily disrupt the heart's normal functioning. Unlike a heart attack caused by blocked arteries, broken heart syndrome occurs without any coronary blockage, yet its symptoms—chest pain, shortness of breath, and irregular heart rhythms—are often equally alarming.

This syndrome most frequently affects women, particularly those over 50, although it can occur in men and younger individuals as well. The intense emotional distress from events such as the loss of a loved one, a breakup, or even a sudden shock can precipitate the condition. In some cases, physical stressors like severe illness, major surgery, or accidents also serve as triggers. The body's release of stress hormones, especially adrenaline, is believed to be the key mechanism behind the temporary weakening of the heart muscle.

When the heart is overwhelmed by a flood of stress hormones, its main pumping chamber may change shape, often ballooning at the top while the lower part contracts normally. This unusual change in the heart's structure has led to the alternate name "takotsubo cardiomyopathy," derived from the Japanese word for an octopus trap, which has a similar shape. Although the condition presents with symptoms that closely resemble those of a heart attack, the absence of significant coronary artery blockages distinguishes it from traditional heart disease.

Diagnosis typically involves a combination of physical examinations, electrocardiograms, blood tests, and imaging studies such as echocardiography or cardiac MRI. These tests help doctors observe the temporary changes in heart structure and function, confirming the diagnosis. Despite the dramatic onset, most patients recover completely within a few weeks when provided with appropriate care, which may include medications to stabilize heart function and reduce its workload, along with stress management techniques.

Understanding broken heart syndrome is essential because it underscores the profound connection between emotional well-being and heart health. Ongoing research by institutions like the Mayo Clinic and Cleveland Clinic continues to improve our understanding of this condition, emphasizing early recognition and timely treatment to prevent complications. This condition reminds us that while the heart is resilient, it is also sensitive to the stresses of life, and that addressing emotional health is a critical component of overall well-being.
