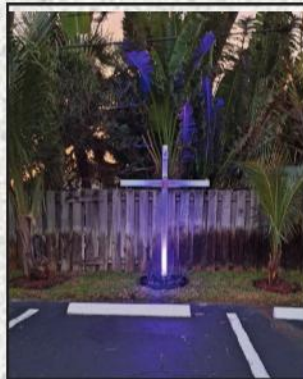
# Third Scrutiny

## The Liturgies of Holy Week

**FEAST OF FAITH**

Holy Week is the culmination of the liturgical year. During these holy days, the liturgy will lead us, with Jesus, to the depths and to the heights.

It begins with a harsh juxtaposition, as we carry palms in remembrance of Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem and then listen to the Passion according to Luke, as the King is handed over for crucifixion. Then, on Holy Thursday, we remember the night Jesus was handed over—the night He gave himself for us and to us, to live in our midst forever in the sacrament of His Body and Blood. On Good Friday, we touch with our hands the mystery of the Lord's Cross, the instrument of torture that has become the tree of life. Then, at the great Easter Vigil, the lighting of the paschal candle speaks to us of the triumph of light over darkness, of life over death. The Resurrection of the Lord becomes a living reality in our midst as the catechumens for whom the Church has prayed throughout Lent are plunged into the mystery of Christ's death and share in the glory of His resurrection. These are indeed holy days, the culmination of the Church's liturgy, and an invitation to participate in the very life of Christ. Come, let us worship.

## What Patients Should Know About GLP-1 Drugs

GLP-1 receptor agonists (GLP-1 RAs) are medications initially used to treat type 2 diabetes. They also help with weight loss by mimicking the GLP-1 hormone, which controls appetite, digestion, and blood sugar.

GLP-1 medications work by: Reducing Hunger: They act on the brain to help you feel full sooner. Slowing Digestion: They delay stomach emptying, keeping you full longer. Regulating Blood Sugar: They help the body use insulin better, preventing sugar spikes.

These drugs are known by different names, depending on their purpose:

- Exenatide: Byetta, Bydureon
- Liraglutide: Victoza (diabetes), Saxenda (weight loss)
- Dulaglutide: **Trulicity** (diabetes)
- Lixisenatide: Adlyxin
- Semaglutide: **Ozempic** (diabetes), Rybelsus (oral), **Wegovy** (weight loss)

Tirzepatide: **Mounjaro** (diabetes), **Zepbound** (weight loss)

GLP-1 medications can be effective for seniors but require caution. Effectiveness: Seniors can benefit as younger adults do. Side Effects: Older adults may be more sensitive to nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea. (Which often improves over time). Pancreatitis Risk: Rare but possible inflammation of the pancreas. Patients with previous GI issues should be cautious with these drugs.

Gallbladder Issues: Rapid weight loss can lead to gallstones. Thyroid Concerns: Animal studies suggest a link to thyroid tumors, though unproven in humans. Your doctor should be made aware if you have a family history of thyroid cancers or tumors. Muscle Loss Risk: Weight loss can reduce muscle mass, so a protein-rich diet and exercise are recommended. Medication Interactions: Seniors often take multiple medications, so doctors should monitor for interactions.

Long term considerations: Heart Health: Some GLP-1 drugs may reduce heart disease risk. Kidney Function: They may help kidneys but can cause dehydration which can become problematic. Thyroid Monitoring: Those with a personal history of thyroid cancer should be cautious.

If you're over 65 and considering GLP-1 drugs, consult your doctor to: Assess Risks and Benefits based on your health. Monitor Side Effects closely. Maintain Muscle Strength through diet and activity. GLP-1 medications can be helpful, but the side effects can outweigh the benefits. Only use medications prescribed by your physician that he/she will monitor closely.
