2026 A SPECIAL YEAR OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI



Pope Leo proclaimed a special Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi to mark the 800th year anniversary of death. The Jubilee Year started in January 10, 2026 to January 10, 2027. The faithful are granted a **plenary indulgence**. Until Jan. 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain this grace under the usual conditions — sacramental confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope — by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

The elderly, the sick, and those who, for serious reasons, cannot leave their homes can obtain the plenary indulgence by spiritually joining in the jubilee celebrations and offering their prayers, pains, or sufferings to God.

A plenary (meaning “full”) indulgence is a special type of indulgence that, if all the requirements are met, removes all temporal punishment due to one’s sin.

BIBLE STUDY

BEGINS FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 13

Our parish Bible Study begins on **February 13, 2026**. We’ll be studying **The Passion and Resurrection Narratives of Jesus**, as found in all four Gospels. These accounts of Jesus’ suffering, death, and resurrection form the basis of our Christian faith in Jesus as Savior and our hope of life eternal and personal resurrection. And, of course, these Gospel accounts are the basis of our central liturgy – The Mass. Studying the Passion and Resurrection accounts can be an excellent way to prepare ourselves for Good Friday and Easter Sunday this year. So we hope you’ll join us. We meet in the Chapel on Friday mornings, from 10 – 11:30 a.m. The study will last 5 or 6 weeks, and the cost is \$20, which includes the cost of the course book you’ll receive on the first day of class.

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

For a humble guy, St. Paul really tells it like it is. It seems some of the Corinthians did not believe that Christ rose from the dead, or that resurrection was a spiritual symbol of forgiveness of sins. So Paul lists those witnesses who actually saw the risen Jesus, last and least of these being Paul himself. Now we are used to thinking of Paul as one of the greatest apostles, even though we know he once persecuted Christians. So you might think he is being overly humble, like someone fishing for a compliment. No, Paul is only interested in making sure the Corinthians understand just how much God has done.

Besides being “born abnormally” (1 Corinthians 15:8), that is, coming to follow Christ in such an unusual way, he felt unworthy because of so many Christians he hurt before his conversion. Yet he turns that unworthiness into an example of how much God has done through him, so he can say that he worked harder than any other apostles because of God’s grace, not Paul’s strength. The same grace that turned a former enemy into a friend also gave him the strength to spread the gospel farther than anyone else at that time.

In today’s Gospel, Peter has a similar experience. He was a fisherman who knew his business and knew that some days, the fish just aren’t there. So when Jesus tells him to go out one more time, try one more cast of the nets, Peter probably thought he’d show Jesus that it was no use. Then when they caught enough fish to fill both boats, he realized that his pride was sinful. He was unworthy to receive such bounty from the Lord. And yet Jesus tells him that “you will be catching men” (Luke 5:10).

How many of us are like Peter and Paul, thinking we know just what our place in the world is, relying on our own strengths to do our jobs? Surely that’s all God expects of us, right? They found Jesus calling them to a much more challenging life. Do we have the courage to listen to God’s call to serve?

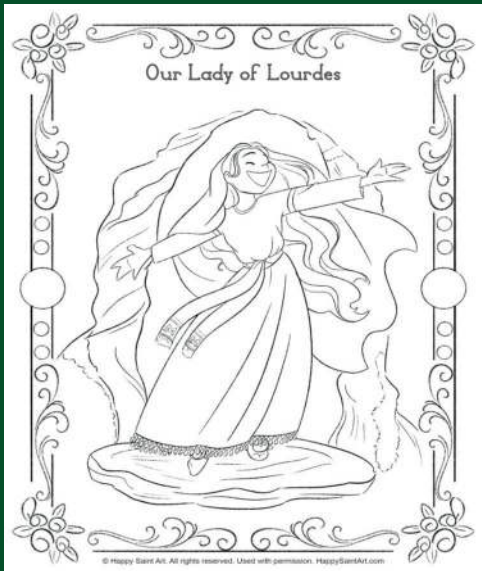

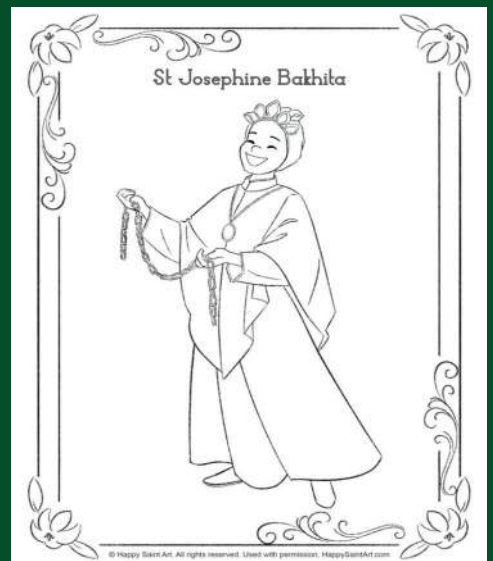
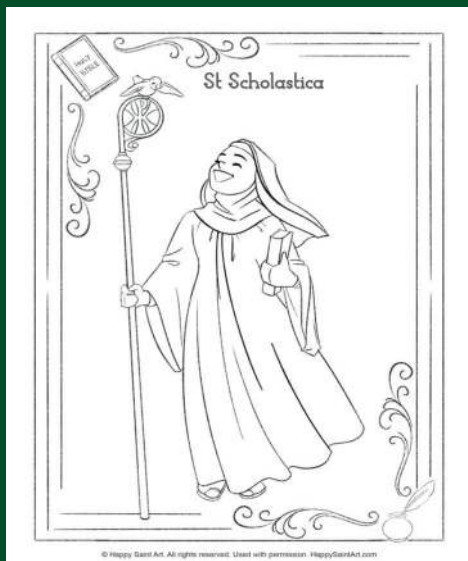
