**Mission Appeal for the
Catholic Diocese of
Warangal, India**



On the weekend of March 14 & 15, Father Albeen Vatti will speak at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in support of the Diocese’s Medical Mission and Tribal Evangelization. Father Vatti is a priest of the Diocese of Warangal and currently serves in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Jackson, Mississippi.

The Warangal Diocese recently established the Father Colombo institute of Medical Sciences, a teaching hospital dedicated to providing quality, affordable healthcare. Now in its third year, the hospital serves thousands of rural undeserved families. Many of its patients are daily wages workers, farmers, and children who otherwise lack access to proper medical care. The Institute also provides medical education rooted in Christian values, forming skilled and compassionate health care professionals. In addition, medical camps bring essential care, maternal services, and health education to remote tribal villages.

To meet the growing needs of the poor, the mission requires expanded facilities, updated equipment and financial support. Your generosity will help care for the sick and train future medical professionals, becoming a true expression of Christ healing love.

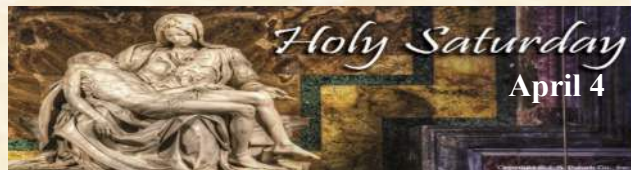

The 40 Days OF LENT

Fourth Sunday of Lent Beware of the Dark Side

Do you remember the Star Wars movies, in which the Dark Side was a symbol of evil? In our second reading Paul tells the Christians in Ephesus that they were once in darkness. Paul uses darkness as a symbol of shame. Shame is not just sorrow for sins; it is the fear of being caught in sin, or of telling our weaknesses to another because we think the other will look down on us. Or you might fear the punishment you think you deserve. Paul was a sinner himself and was blinded when Jesus appeared to him, asking, “Why do you persecute me?” So he knew that the only way to be free of shame is not to hide sins, but to expose them.

Does that mean we have to broadcast our sins on the evening news, or post them all on our social media pages? No; we just need to confess them to God and receive God’s forgiveness. We can do this through the sacrament of reconciliation. The priest shows that God loves sinners, no matter what they have done. When you injure your arm, you explain how you hurt it, so the doctor knows how to treat it. If you wreck your car, you take it to the repair shop and tell the mechanics what is broken so they can repair it. In reconciliation we bring our sins to the priest so that we can experience forgiveness. You could leave your car at the shop overnight, with enough cash to make the repairs, but until you come back and claim your car, you will never know if it was fixed.

Sometimes other people try to shame us. In today’s Gospel, Jesus’ disciples asked whose sin caused the man to be born blind. The Pharisees told the man that he was born in sin. Jesus, however, told his disciples that the man had not sinned, and furthermore, the Pharisees themselves were the sinners because they had judged the blind man. So when we know that God forgives us and still loves us, we don’t have to fear what others might think. Let us instead hold our sins up to the light of forgiveness and be free of our shame. *Tom Schmidt*



Fourth Sunday of Lent TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Centuries ago, these Lenten days were a time of intense final preparation for the candidates for baptism. By now, they had already been numbered among the “elect” for Easter baptism, and were daily challenged to excel in prayer, in fasting, and in works of charity. As is true today, at a certain point in the weekly assembly for Eucharist, the nonbaptized were dismissed from the assembly for their own learning and prayer. While they might have had impressions about the Eucharist, they had no direct experience. The rites of the church were secret and its worship places off-limits.

For the Easter Vigil, those to be baptized arrived very hungry from long fasting, and perhaps very apprehensive as to how initiation was to be accomplished. A long night of vigil and storytelling, a shimmering pool of baptism, the anointing with oil and clothing with white robes came as something of a surprise. At the end of a long, life-changing night of embrace by Christ and the community, as the eucharistic feast ended, a final surprise was brought forward. To address the deep hunger of the newly baptized, the church offered a bowl of milk and honey, sign of promises fulfilled, sign of community, prosperity, and peace, and yet another foretaste of heaven’s banquet.

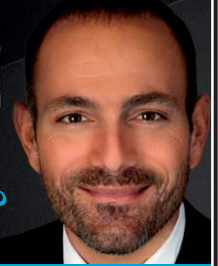
