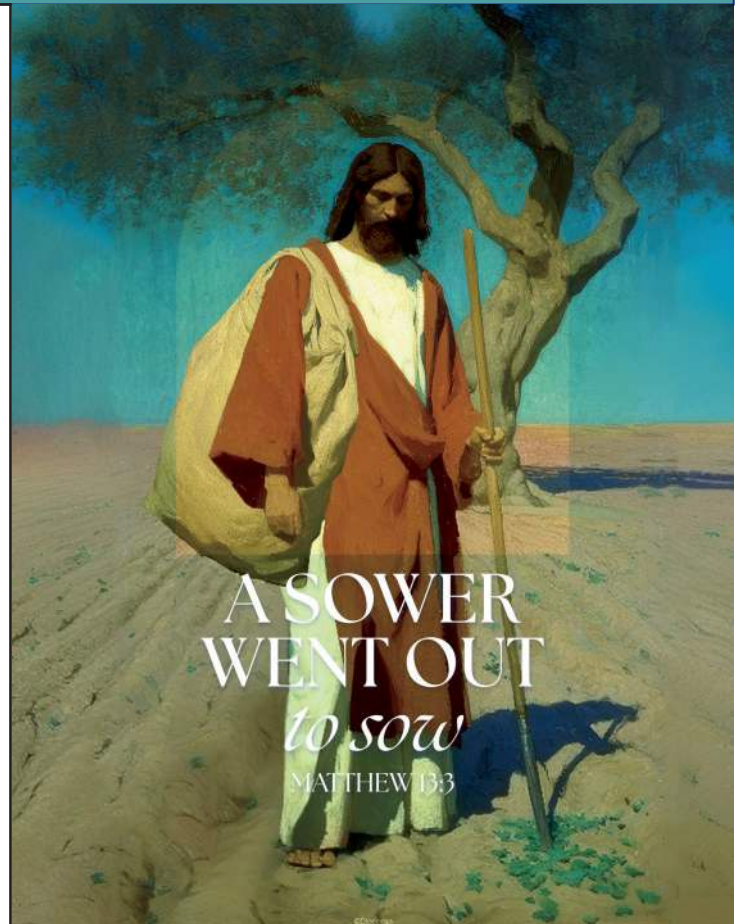

Important Message from Bishop Manuel

In the matter of: The Priestly Fraternity of Saint Pius X - SSPX-

Following the illicit ordination July 1 of four bishops by the Society of St. Pius X without Vatican authorization and the subsequent excommunication of adherents of the now-schismatic group, Bishop Manuel de Jesús Rodríguez has issued a decree explaining the canonical status of the SSPX in the Diocese of Palm Beach.

The decree states that all sacraments, especially Eucharist, penance and matrimony, celebrated by the SSPX within the five-county Diocese of Palm Beach are invalid. All SSPX clerics and lay adherents are barred from preaching, teaching, conducting retreats or exercising any ministry in the diocese.

All diocesan entities (parishes, missions, schools, apostolates or other organizations) are prohibited from sponsoring, hosting, promoting or facilitating SSPX activities. And diocesan clerics ministering in the diocese are never to concelebrate or participate in SSPX ministries.

The decree also sets forth procedures for SSPX priests and lay faithful to return to full communion with the Catholic Church if they so desire.

To read the entire decree and to see the worship sites located within the territory of the Diocese of Beach that are not in communion with the Roman Pontiff, thus not to be considered Catholic, please visit this link.

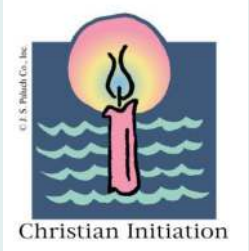

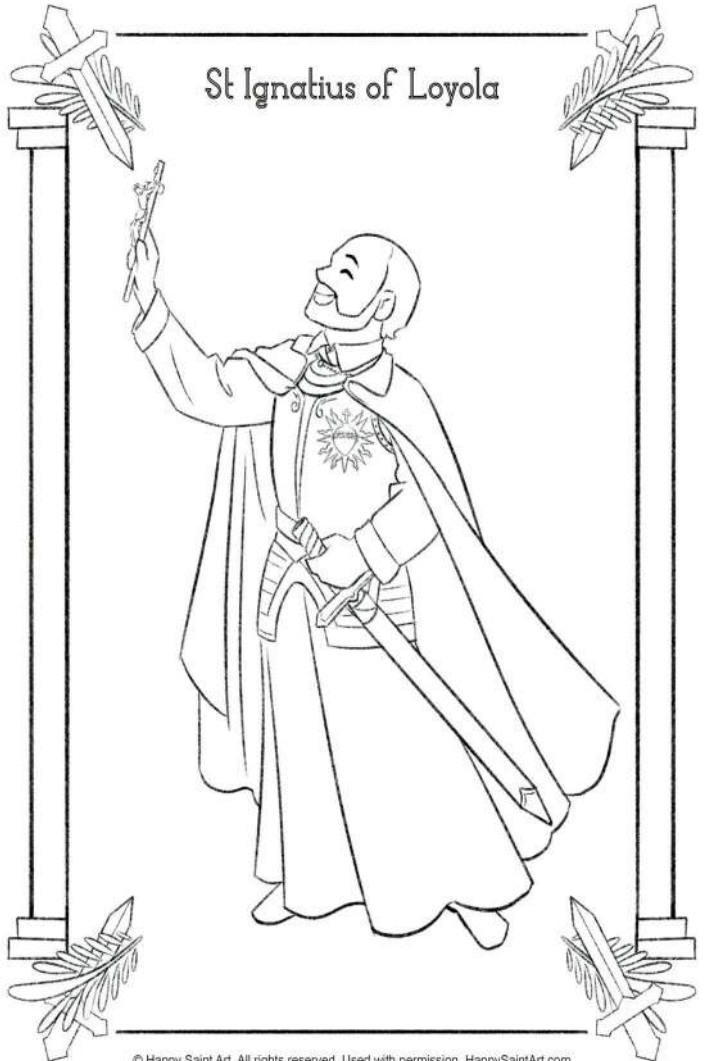

When the Heart Breaks and When the Heart Heals *Broken Heart Syndrome: Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy* By Your Faith Community Nurses

The month of June invites us to reflect on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a symbol of God's divine love that beats with compassion for every human struggle. As a faith community, we know that the Sacred Heart of Jesus is more than an image, but a reminder that God's love meets us in our vulnerability and heals our wounded hearts.

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves."
(Matthew 11:28-29)

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a heart that knows sorrow, a heart that understands human suffering, a heart that breaks for us but never abandons us, and a heart that restores, strengthens, and renews us. In our daily experiences, we may have experienced that our physical hearts and our spiritual hearts are deeply connected. Some people may say, they have a broken heart when they are hurt or have experienced loss; in the medical field, there is a syndrome known as the *"Broken Heart Syndrome"*, also known as stress cardiomyopathy or *Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy*. (Harvard Health, 2026).

Understanding Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy

Takotsubo cardiomyopathy, named in 1990 after a Japanese octopus trap that resembles the shape of the heart during the event, is cardiac condition described as the weakening of left ventricle of the heart. Takotsubo cardiomyopathy often occurs after intense emotional or severe physical stress, such as:

- Grief or loss
- Sudden fear or shock
- Conflict or emotional overwhelm
- Major life transitions

The symptoms of Takotsubo cardiomyopathy can mimic a heart attack with symptoms such as chest pain, shortness of breath, and profound fatigue. Yet unlike a heart attack, the coronary arteries are usually clear. Most people recover fully with proper care, but the experience is real, frightening, and deeply emotional. Individuals who experience stress with this condition does not only affect their mind and their emotions, but it can also literally reshape their heart.

Research continues to show that faith, prayer, and community support can reduce stress, improve coping, and promote healing. Spiritual practices can help regulate the nervous system and bring peace to the heart.

Here are gentle practices that support both physical and spiritual heart health:

- *Breath prayer*: "Jesus, meek and humble of heart... make my heart like Yours."
- *Sacred rest*: Honoring the body's need for stillness.
- *Community connection*: Sharing burdens with trusted companions.
- *Gratitude reflection*: A proven stress-reducing practice.
- *Acts of compassion*: Acts that strengthen both giver and receiver.
- *Exercise*: Increase physical strength and well-being

For those who have experienced Takotsubo cardiomyopathy, or are experiencing any emotional heartbreak, the Feast of the Sacred Heart offers a profound message: *Your heart may feel overwhelmed, but you are held by a LOVE that does not fail.* Takotsubo cardiomyopathy reminds us that the heart is vulnerable. The Sacred Heart of Jesus reminds us that the heart is also redeemable. As we honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus, may we care tenderly for our own hearts and the hearts of those we serve with compassion, and the healing love of Christ.
